A native of North Carolina, Dr. Gonzalez holds a Bachelors of Science degree in International Business from High Point University, High Point, North Carolina, a Masters in International Studies from the University of Leeds, Leeds, England, and a Doctorate in Higher Education Administration from The George Washington University, Washington, D.C. Dr. Gonzalez is currently the Chief Administrative officer of the Dragas Center for Economic Analysis and Policy, Strome College of Business Old Dominion University, Norfolk, Virginia.

Dr. Gonzalez' research interests include the Economics of Social Issues and Domestic and International Migration. Her work has been published in the United States, and she has presented her research at Harvard University and the UK Ministry of Defense in Shrivenham, England. She is a Summer Scholar and recipient of a U.S. National Endowment for the Humanities Landmarks Grant. She is Quality Matter Expert (SME) in Economics for a network of over 750 universities from 47 different U.S. states and 6 countries. She is a Certified Microsoft Faculty Fellow and a Faculty Contributor in Economics to Macmillan Education Corporation.
