State Senator **Janet Howell**, the longest serving female Virginia Senator and one of the Commonwealth's most influential leaders.

Virginia Senator and one of the Commonwealth's most influential leaders, will speak about women leading the way in politics. She has served in the State Senate since 1992 and is the first woman to chair the powerful Senate Finance and Appropriations Committee.

She will be retiring at the end of this term, and we will honor her for the immense work she has done to promote the education, health, and equality of women and girls in Virginia.

Among her many achievements, **Senator Howell** is credited with major legal reforms. She headed the overhaul of Virginia's family violence laws. She spearheaded the mental health law reform in the Senate following the Virginia Tech tragedy. Additionally, Virginia has genetic information privacy legislation due to her efforts. Her work has been widely praised and honored by many groups including the American Academy of Pediatrics, Virginia Sheriffs, and the Virginia Interfaith Center.

She earned her BA at Oberlin College and her MA at the University of Pennsylvania.
